



### JavaScript Terminology and Syntax Cheat Sheet

### **Variables**

A jar to store a something you might want to use again in your code.

```
var myStringVariable = "whatever"
var myNumberVariable = 42
var myBooleanVariable = true // can only be 'true' or 'false'
```

You can also over-write exiting variables and give them a new value. Note the omission of the var keyword.

```
myNumberVariable = 7;
```

### **Functions**

A group of code that can be run repeatedly.

### Defining a function (write out a set of instructions)

```
function myFunction(){
    //do stuff
}

//OR (alternate syntax)
```

foo bar borrring GET BORED REALLY EASILY.

```
var halloween = {
 date: 'Oct 31',
 colours: ['black', 'orange'],
 awesome: true,
  getCandy: function() {
    console.log('trick or treat!');
```


### Frontend framework hell




